Morand and Morgan reach milestones

Harrington regulars Tony Morgan and Jim Morand both reached significant driving milestones at Harrington in 2009. Morgan earned his 13,000th win in the spring, while Morand notched his 8,000th in the fall. Morgan became just the 4th driver in harness racing history to reach 13,000, while Morand is one of only 18 pilots with at least 8,000 victories. Morand and Morgan ironically, also rank as Harrington's top two drivers in track history in terms of wins.

CALLAHAN, COREY

Age: 32 **Birthplace:** Maryland

- Started driving at age 25
- Won his first race at Rosecroft.
- First track he ever drove at was Rosecroft Raceway.
- Best horse he's ever driven: Western Ace
- Most memorable win: 9/14/2008, Western Ace in 1:49.4 at Chester Downs.
- Callahan comes from a harness racing family and returned to his racing roots after a reprieve from the sport while he pursued a professional career after college. He teamed up with trainer George Teague to burst on the national scene driving stakes winners such as Delmaravlous in 2009. He learned the business from father Nick, one of the top trainers in the region.



COLE, MIKE

Age: 30 **Birthplace:** Delaware

- Started driving at age 18
- Won his first race at Ocean Downs
- First track he ever drove at was Ocean Downs.
- Best horse he's ever driven: Cam's Fortune
- Most memorable win: Toofunnyforwards 2000 Presidents Cup
- Cole has been a regular in the top 10 of the drivers standings the last 7 years. Cole manages a small stable while also picking up catch drives for a number of local trainers. He surpassed 1,000 career wins in 2009 and is the step son of driver/trainer George Dennis.



DAVIS JR, EDDIE

Age: 44 **Birthplace:** Delaware

- Started driving at age 16
- Won his first race at Liberty Bell Park
- First track he ever drove at was Liberty Bell.
- Best horse he's ever driven: Roddy's Bags Again
- Most memorable win: Snickers Hanover 2001 Presidents Cup
- The son of highly accomplished driver Eddie Davis, he has been a leading driver in Delaware since moving back to his home state from Maine in 1998. Davis Jr. is Harrington's 2nd all-time leading money winner with more than \$10 million in purses and has the 3rd most wins.



DENNIS, GEORGE

Age: 39 **Birthplace:** Delaware

- Started driving at age 16
- Won his first race at Ocean Downs
- First track he ever drove at was Harrington.
- Best horse he's ever driven: Shark Sation
- George not only makes a racing career from driving, but as a trainer as well. A winner of more than 3,800 lifetime races, he is a regular among the top 10 in the driver standings at Harrington and finished in the top five on the trainers side as well in 2009. His trotter Fivedollarsforsox was co-winner of trotter of the meet honors as named by the DSOA for his 2009 Harrington accolades.



GIVENS, BRANDON

Age: 23

Birthplace: Delaware

- Started driving at age 18
- Won his first race at Harrington Raceway
- Best horse he's ever driven: The Queen of Trash

- Givens '06 and '07 seasons were cut short by unfortunate injuries in an accident at Harrington. He reached 1,000 wins at Ocean Downs over the summer of 2009. He finished second in the driver standings in the 2005 meet in his maiden year of racing. He learned the business from his father Les, and uncle Wayne.



KIRBY, VICTOR

Age: 37

Birthplace: Delaware

- Started driving at age 22
- Won his first race at Ocean Downs
- Best horse he's ever driven: Allmar Surprise
- Most memorable win: Total Truth 2005 Wayne Smullin Memorial (Rosecroft).

- Kirby won the 2000 DSOA Horizon Rising Star award and is one of the more popular personalities on the circuit. Kirby also is an active trainer, managing a small stable of horses. Trotting mare Allmar Surprise is the star of his stable and set the track record for mares at Harrington in 2009, while sharing trotter of the meet honors by the DSOA for her banner Harrington campaign.



MORGAN, ANTHONY

Age: 51

Birthplace: Ohio

- Started driving at age 13
- Won his first race at Celina Ohio Matinee
- First track he drove at was Henderson
- Best horses he's ever driven: "The last one I won with."
- Most memorable win: 10,000th win at Dover Downs

- A winner of more than 13,000 races lifetime, Morgan burst onto the Delaware scene becoming only the second driver in history to win over 1,000 races in a year. He set new records at Harrington and Dover for both earnings, wins and win percentages. On many of his days off in Delaware, Morgan travels to Pennsylvania, New Jersey and New York to race.



MORAND, JIM

Age: 45

Birthplace: Ontario (Canada)

- Started driving when he was 16
- Won his first race at Northfield
- Best horse he's ever driven: Kiev Hanover/Rainbow Blue
- Most memorable win: Kiev Hanover (1990) Lexington

- A winner of nearly 8,000 races lifetime, he is one of the quickest drivers in history to reach the milestone. He has won more races at Harrington than any other driver. Many of those wins have come driving for top trainers like George Teague, Steve Leblanc, Les Givens, Wayne Givens and Joe Hunderptfund. He has won multiple stakes, but is perhaps best remembered for his efforts on Governor's Day in '99, when he won 5 of the card's 10 races.



PLANTE JR., ROGER

Age: 43 **Birthplace:** New Hampshire

- Started driving at age 16
- Won his first race at Foxboro Raceway.
- First track he drove at was Foxboro Raceway.
- Best horse he's ever driven: Seasin
- Most memorable win: So Sinful - The Meadowlands 1996

- In 2007, he posted his best year to date as a driver, finishing as Harrington's sixth leading reinsman, while setting personal bests for wins and earnings for the year. Plante drives all horses out of his mother's barn (Phyllis Copeland), and shares drives for many top barns such as Eric Ell and Steve LeBlanc.



WOLFENDEN, ROSS

Age: 47 **Birthplace:** New Zealand

- Started driving at age 18
- Won his first race at Ruakaka (NZ).
- First track he drove at was Auckland Trotting Club.
- Best horse he's ever driven: Oye Vay

- "Wolfman" continues to be a top driver on the Delaware circuit. Well-liked by his peers, Ross has been a top five driver since making the move to the First State shortly after the new millennium.. The native Kiwi balances his drives among many large stables such as Joe Hundertpfund Jr., Peter Tritton and Steve LeBlanc. He is rapidly approaching 4,500 career victories.

- Best horse he's trained: Stinging Scooter/Redford Hall/Art's Fantasy
- Started training at age 15

- Crissman earned his first training title at Harrington in 2008 and was quick to repeat in 2009. He trained 2006 Harrington Fall Horse of the Meet, Quick and Deadly. - He had a career year in 2006 and topped it in 2007, while doing even better in '08. He has a solid relationship with driver Tony Morgan and together they formed a dominant. Crissman and his wife Patti moved to Delaware from Ohio nearly a decade ago. - Davis was the 2006 Horizon Award winner, given by the DSOA for a rising star in racing. He had a breakout year in 2006 with top 2-year-old Artzina, who won both the Dan Patch and Nova award as the top sport's top freshman colt. Davis has been extremely productive with claimers and remains a top conditioner in the region. He has campaigned some higher conditioned trotters as well over the last few years at Harrington.



DAVIS, JANET

Age: 38 **Birthplace:** New Brunswick, Canada

- Won her first race at Scarborough Downs
- Best horse she's trained: Snickers Hanover
- Started training at age 8

- Davis is the husband of one of the area's top drivers, Eddie Davis Jr. She maintains a large stable of horses and had a solid 2009 campaign. Her horses were consistently competitive throughout the meet at Harrington while maintaining a balanced stable of pacers and trotters. She had an emotional retirement ceremony for her veteran pacer Snickers Hanover on October 27 at Harrington. 'Snickers', known as 'Meatball' by his connections was a top horse in the region for a good portion of the new millennium.

- Started training at age 23.

- Givens enjoyed his best season to date as a trainer in 2009, with a career high of 166 wins. Many of his horses were driven by his son Brandon and Jim Morand. Les maintains a stable primarily of claimers, but maintains a good balance. He and his brother Wayne have been dominant over the past several years in the DSBF program for trotters. Givens has previously won training titles at Ocean Downs.

- The older Givens brother has trained horses for more than 40 years. He's had an abundance of top horses the past several years including Winbak Speed, Brian P, Yankee Vista, Gamblers Dream and Pacific Illusion. He's had ample success with horses in the DSBF program, as well as with the seasoned older horses. He currently ranks as Harrington's second leading trainer of all-time.



GREEN, JOSH

- Started training at age 12.

- Green burst on the racing scene in Delaware in 2002 and earned his first training title in '03. He has a record six training titles to his credit on Delaware's half-mile racetrack. He's had success in claiming races, and with top older horses such as Royal Art, Sharky Osborne, Fake Denario N, Giddy Up Lucky and Sportsfancy.
